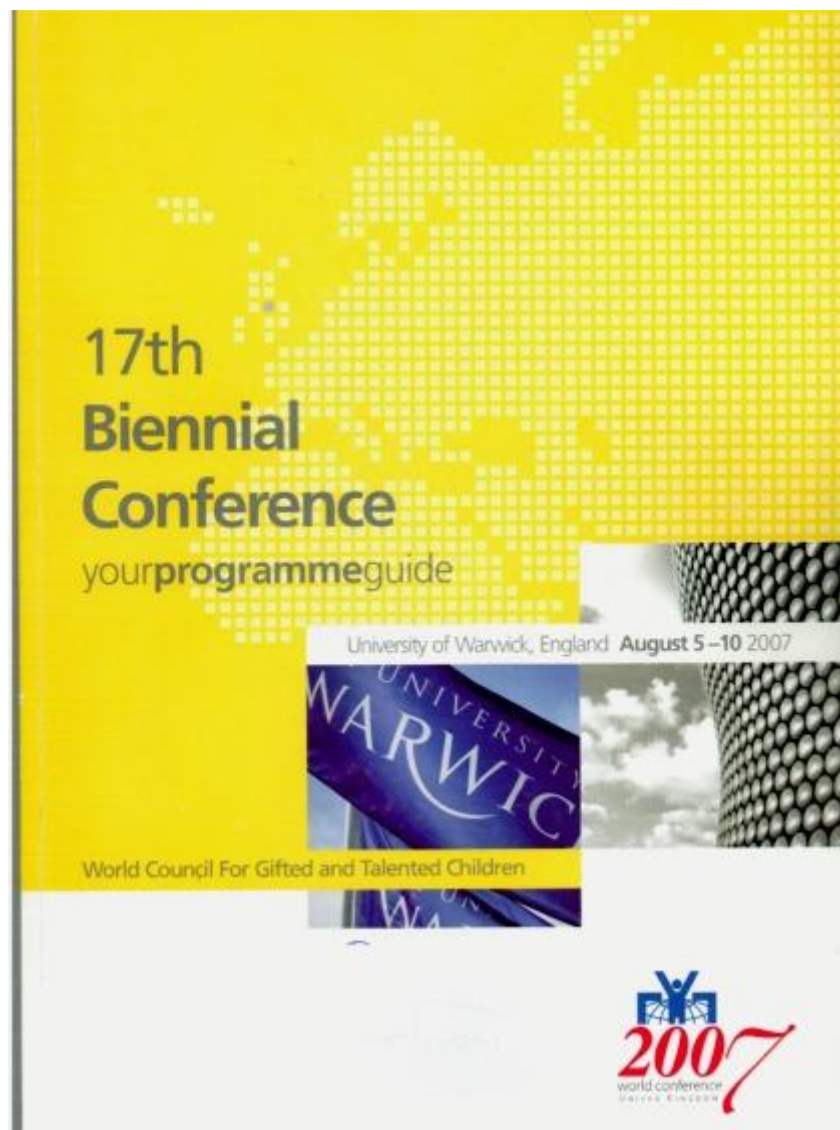

When Talenta started with nine children (6-12 years) in August 1998, the pioneer school in Zurich was a "high risk startup". Since then some 100 children have left Talenta and over 80 per cent have gone on to Grammar School. What happens to bored and/or tormented children at risk? And what makes the difference at Talenta? The presentation exposes methods and practical results like: exploring science and languages, pedagogical rhythm, drill and creativity, social learning in group settings, and working with parents. It also discusses the forthcoming Pre-Talenta School, making the same opportunities available to children from 3 to 6.		
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
